The Bible Says

You have been blessed that you might be a blessing. The Bible says that debt is a curse (Deut 28:44-45) and the borrower is servant (slave) to the lender (Prov 22:7). lesus came to set the captives free (Gal 5:1) and to release people from the curse into blessing (Gal 3:13-14).

Have you considered helping to set others free?

God's Word clearly teaches that His people should not become entangled with the world, making themselves servants of it with heavy debt and interest repayments (Rom 12:2, Neh 5:1-13). Instead we should serve and support one another in love (Gal 5:13).

Debt-free home ownership is God's ideal (Micah 4:4), so that His people can be free to fully fulfil His plan for their lives.

How can we help each other into homes today?

Interest Free Lending

Liberty Trust began in 1989 with a direction from God that we should "pool our resources and lend to one another without interest". We seek to advance the Christian faith by teaching and demonstrating the Bible's financial principles to provide liberty to

every household and church and advance the Kingdom of God.

Liberty Trust enables biblically based (Deut 23:20, 28:12, Pr 28:8) interest free mortgages for New Zealand housing and church buildings following the principle of sowing and reaping (2 Cor 9:6-15). These mortgages are generally repaid over 7-10 years enabling borrowers to be released from financial burdens and to generously serve and build God's Kingdom.

Begin a Biblical Heritage

In Bible times young couples were commonly helped into home ownership by their parents and extended families (Prov 19:14). This concept of community support has largely been lost in today's western culture. As a result each household wastes many hundreds of thousands of dollars paying rent and mortgage interest, unable to give and serve God with true liberty.

God's pattern is for families to provide for and train their children in His principles by both word and example (Dt 11:19, Prov 22:6). With your assistance your family can be debt free with their own homes while their peers are still saving for a deposit! They can be released from financial burdens to be a blessing to God's greater Kingdom. You will have established a biblical heritage for future generations (Pr 13:22, 1 Ti 5:8).

This is also an ideal way to equip your pastors, missionaries and Christian workers (Eph 4:12), and provide for church buildings interest free.
