As a solo Mum I had fretted quietly many times over my mortgage payments which were interest only, and many times I had been reassured by God's Word. At first I was not really aware of the great blessing, but as I told people how Liberty Trust works, I realised, enormously, how God's way is best.

I suppose the best off-shoot of receiving an interest-free mortgage, apart from the massive saving in interest, is my opportunities to tell non-Christians about it. Liberty Trust is a mighty witness to the Mighty God we serve. Many blessings to you all, Thanks, Adrienne.

A Letter from David and Susan Mitchell, Tauranga

Thank you for volunteering your time and talents to enable us, and in time hundreds of others to be free of debt.

Last year we had a bank mortgage with 20 years to pay off. We would still be paying off our first mortgage into our sixties.

Now with the intervention of Liberty Trust, we will have paid back the capital you have invested in my mortgage within seven years. Through this I have saved 13 years of my life which I would otherwise have spent working to pay interest to a bank.


