

It is Saturday night as I sit down before a cosy tile-fire and catch up on the mail that has been put into my "too hard" basket throughout the week.




Among them are five eloquently written, heart-pulling newsletters from Christian Ministries, which my wife and I support from time to time. They describe very real financial needs, which I know, are but "a drop in the bucket" to what they really need to do God's work out there. They only ask for a little because they know even that will be hard won. Even their own service becomes a financial sacrifice. Why? We are still a long way from answering Christ's call: to "go into all the world and preach the gospel". Despite the might growth in the Church world-wide we are still not keeping pace with the increase in its population. And, how many un-reached peoples remain?

Why is the Church always limited by finance? The oil-rich Moslems aren't. Cynics will say that God has to keep us poor to avoid the temptation of riches. Either that is untrue or the Church is a long long way from the triumphal state it will be in, I read, in the "last days".

It is now 10 years since God spoke the simple instruction to us, to "pool our resources and pay off each other's mortgages". God was talking about the "storehouse", where the tithes were brought (Deut 14 v 28-29) for all those in need, including the Levites.

'For the work of the gospel and those in need', is still the first priority of the storehouse. Its second is the elimination of the huge cost of mortgage interest and rent (approximately a quarter of a million dollars per family) paid by God's people in contravention of God's principles, that they may give liberally in liberty. How? By obedience to God's principles we will. God's principles are the only answer to mankind's madness, the only ones that work.



*Dear Trustees,*

*After receiving a small legacy several years ago we felt to pass it to our children for their future inheritance (Proverbs 13 verse 22 "A good man leaves an inheritance for his children's children). We formed a family trust and borrowed 80% from a bank to invest in another home and for the rent to pay the interest over twenty-five years.*

*About the same time we joined Liberty Trust and have recently received an interest free loan eliminating bank interest completely and the loan will be paid off over approximately nine years.*

*In time our children will be able to use the money from not paying bank interest for their future education and later the investment can be used as a deposit on their own homes.*

*What a wonderful blessing and provision from the Lord through Liberty Trust. Thank you everyone involved in Liberty Trust, may God bless you all richly in Jesus name.*
